## Minutes of the Board of Directors Meeting Huber Airpark Homeowners Association

**Capital Improvement Plan:** The bulk of the meeting dealt with the near-term capital improvement plan for Huber Air Park. Here are some very rough estimates for the needed capital improvements:

## Runway: Lights, Crack seal, topcoat, renumber, and paint:

Total:		\$225,000
Beacon and windsock Relocation:		\$ 10,000
Security: Fencing, new gate, gate operator		\$ 80,000

**Property Assessment:** If these estimates are correct, the dollar cost of capital improvements will require an assessment from the property owners in the \$7,500 per lot range. We are still looking for an estimate from Ameriseal® to crack seal, topcoat, renumber, and paint the runway. Ameriseal's better quality, longer lasting runway seal may alter the estimate.

**Next Property Owners Meeting:** The next property owners meeting has been rescheduled for Wednesday April 27<sup>th</sup>, at Hangar 25 (597 Beechcraft Lane) at 5:30 p.m.
